Health Rules for Goats

General Rules for Goats

Judging

- All animals in a CLASS will be judged together.
- An animal in a Class will NOT be able to win more than ONE PLACE.
- Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged.
- Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out to competing.
- When on exhibition in the ring, each animal must be under halter and in charge of owner or owner's representative.
- Open classes, 4-H & FFA project animals and Youth under 19 must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.

Superintendent:

- The Senior Champion class shall consist of all first-place winners in the first three classes or Doe one-year old and fewer than 2, and older animals.
- The Junior Champion class shall consist of all first-place winners in classes 2 and 3 or Doe one-year old and fewer than 3 and younger animals.
- Grand Champion Class shall consist of best of breed in each division.
- Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Sire.

The Exhibitor:

- Is limited to show no more than 2 animals in each class of the breeds listed.
 - Will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the Superintendent may direct.
 - Will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent; to accept the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance, and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may be to increase the educational value of the show.
 - Will not display decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at other shows until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges.
 - That has any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fair grounds.
 - Joint ownership considered being as one owner in accordance with registration papers.
 - Will provide dividers to separate doe and kids.
 - Animals must be on the Fair Grounds no later than 3pm Monday.
 - Must keep pens presentable during the week.
