### General Regulations for Horses Shown at Halter

#### Judging:

- State 4-Horse rules will apply
- All Animals in a CLASS will be judged together.
- An animal in a Class will NOT be able to win more than ONE PLACE
- If the number of entries does not warrant all the below classes, several may be combined; e.g. 3-year-olds and 2-year-olds may be combined, and yearlings and 2-year-olds may be combined.
- Premiums will be reimbursable when paid for Horse or Pony shows if these events are competitive and open to all participants.
- If the fairs is holding a Quarter Horse Show approved by A.Q.H.A., then the rules and classes described in the Official Handbook of A.Q.H.A. shall prevail.

## Heavy Draft, Registered

General Regulations for Draft Horses

### Judging:

- All animals must compete and be shown.
- No horse or team of horses shall be entitled to a premium unless serviceably sound.
- In no case is it permissible to show mixed breeds in the same class or division to be judged against each other for premiums.
- Open classes (19 and over) must be present and have charge of their animals at the same time of judging.

### Superintendent:

- The fair reserves the right to refuse any or all entries.
- A purebred registration certificate must be supplied to the Division Superintendent at his request.

**Exhibitor:**

- One person or firm must own horses entered as matched pairs.
- No grade stallions shall be accepted for entry.
- Open Class Horse & Ponies must meet the Equine Health Requirements.
- Must show the same horse through all classes.
- Animals or combinations of animals owned by one exhibitor may be entered in the classes following.
- Animals must be on the Fair Grounds no later than 3pm Monday.
- No males over 2 years old.
- Must keep pens presentable during the week.
- Also, must clean pens after you take animals out of the pen. You were assigned failure will result from the exhibitor's being able to show at the Cookport Fair the following year.
