General Regulations for Beef Cattle

Judging:

- All animals in a CLASS will not be judged together
- An animal in a Class will NOT be able to win more than ONE PLACE.
- Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged.
- Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out to competing.
- When on exhibition in the ring, each animal must be under halter and in charge of owner or owner's representative. In addition to open classes, 4-H and FFA project animals and Youth under 19 will be judged for 4-H and FA premiums.
- However, open classes, 4-H and FFA members and Youth under 19 must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.

Superintendent:

- May call upon current membership, GRAND CHAMPION: Champion and Reserve Champion of each breed and the crossbreed division will compete for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Steer of the fair.
- All classes will be held together and conducted on time.

Exhibitor:

- Must keep pens presentable during the week
- Also, must clean pens after you take animals out of the pen. You were assigned failure will result from the exhibitor's being able to show at the Cookport Fair the following year.
- Exhibitors are limited to show not more than 2 animals in each class of the Beef Breeds listed.
- The exhibitors will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the Superintendent may direct.
- Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent; to accept the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance, and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may be to increase the educational value of the show.
- Decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at shows shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges.
- Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fair grounds.
- Joint ownership considered being as one owner in accordance with registration papers.
- Crossbred steers shall be classified according to the breed of the sire.
- No males over 2 years old
- Animals must be on the Fair Grounds no later than 3pm Monday.

Entry Form:

4-H & FFA must use the Department number 10 and may enter in open class Department number 01.

Youth 19 and under must use the Department number 11 and may enter in open class Department number 01.

Open Class use the Department number 01.
